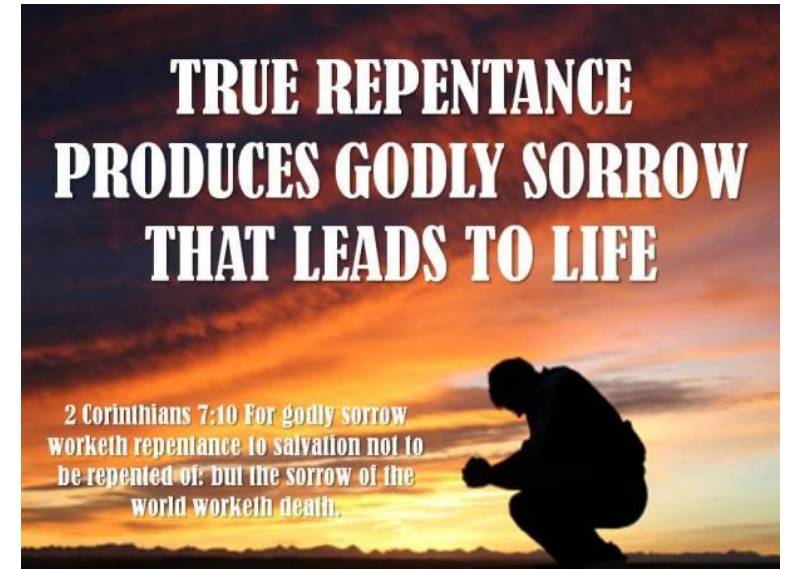

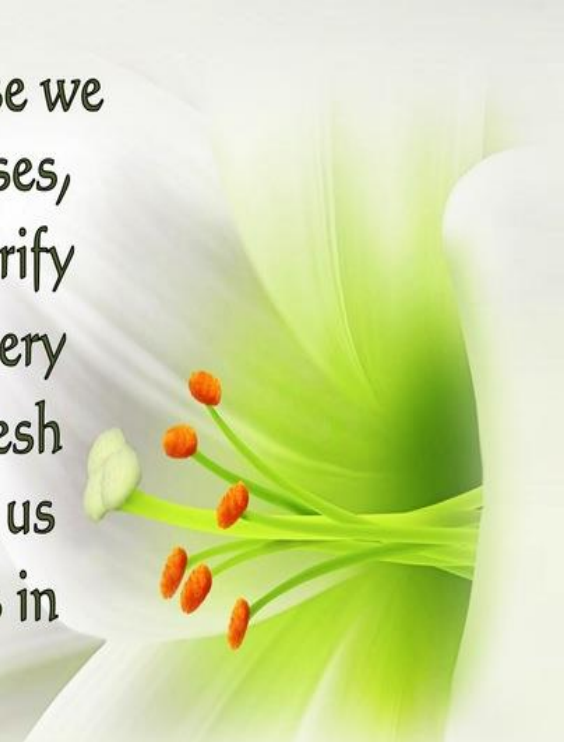

# When you are truly sorry for your sin...

**1. It brings renewed comfort** verses 2-8

**2. It brings renewed concern** verses 9-12

- “I must repent now!”

- “I will no make excuses about my sin.”
- “I am afraid of sinning against God.”
- “I want to be right, more than anything.”
- “I will do what it takes to sort my life out.”
- “I will not be half-hearted.”
